Emergency Supply List

- Water and non-perishable food for several days
- o Extra cell phone battery or charger
- O Battery-powered or hand crank radio that can receive
- O NOAA Weather Radio tone alerts and extra batteries
- O Flashlight and extra batteries
- O First aid kit
- O Whistle to signal for help
- O Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic
- O sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place
- O Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for
- Opersonal sanitation
- O Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- O Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- O Local maps

Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- O Prescription medications and glasses
- O Infant formula and diapers
- O Pet food, water and supplies for your pet
- O Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies,
- O identification and bank account records in a portable waterproof container

- O Matches in a waterproof container
